- ➤ **Roe Memorial Mass** at 10:30 a.m. at Cathedral Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe (Mass will also be livestreamed at youtube.com/cathedralguadalupe),
- ➤ Walking with Moms in Need Donation Drive from 10 a.m. 11:30 a.m. outside the Cathedral (donations of diapers and baby wipes requested).
