The second-ever 40 Days for Life campaign was held in Dallas in the winter of 2004-05, in front of Aaron's late-term abortion facility, from December 12 through January 22, anniversary of the Roe vs. Wade U.S. Supreme Court decision which erroneously legalized abortion in America through all nine months of pregnancy. The campaign was extremely sacrificial -- it was cold and took place over the holiday season. But God honored our sacrifice, and not only did Aaron's late term abortuary close last summer, but as you drive on eastbound LBJ Freeway and look where it used to stand between Preston and Hillcrest, you will see that it has been leveled to the ground, without even a trace!

It is time for another intensive prayer campaign against the grave evil of late-term abortions in Dallas. We are inviting **all people of faith**, across all denominational lines, to pray and fast for an end to abortion during this next 40 Days for Life Winter Campaign. Will you join us?

40 Days for Life is an intensive effort designed to raise awareness, save lives, bring healing and conversion, and lead our city to repentance for the sin of abortion as we pray for an end to the killing. In addition to 40 days of prayer and fasting, please come and pray on site at our peaceful, prayerful vigil: **December 12-January 22, 4 hours per day - 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon, 7 days a week**, outside of the new **Southwestern late-term abortuary (babies are being aborted through 24 weeks, or 6 months of pregnancy), 8616 Greenville Avenue at Royal Lane (NE corner), Dallas**, and spread the word to others about this critical life-saving effort!
