

Attention Youth Ministers!

You and your youth are invited to be a part of
The Bishop's 15th Annual Catholic Pro-Life Dinner
on Saturday, April 5, 2008, at the Hilton Anatole Dallas
Chantilly Ballroom, 2201 Stemmons Freeway, Dallas

The featured keynote speaker will be Fr. Frank Pavone, M.E.V., National Director of Priests for Life, the President of the National Pro-Life Religious Council, the Pastoral Director of Rachel's Vineyard and the Founder and Moderator General of the Missionaries of the Gospel of Life.

- ✠ Middle school volunteers, ages 12 to 14, are needed for general set-up and flower preparation.
- ✠ High school volunteers, ages 14 to 18, are needed for general set-up, hospitality and clean-up.
- ✠ College-age and adult volunteers are needed for registration, the silent auction, and coordination of the youth.

Schedule for the day: (Tentative)

9:30 – Early shift volunteers gather, receive instructions and begin set-up	5:00 – Silent Auction begins and VIP guests attend private reception
12:30 – Early shift ends	6:30 – Bishop's Dinner begins
4:00 – High school volunteers gather and receive instructions for the evening	9:30 – Dinner is over and clean-up begins High school and college volunteers should expect to stay until at least 11:00 p.m.
4:30 – Be in place to begin welcoming guests	

- ❑ Any adult, age 18 and up, who will be working with youth must submit proof, at least 1 week prior to the event, that they have been cleared by the Safe Environment Program at their parish.
- ❑ There must be at least one cleared adult, age 21 and up, attending with every nine youth.
- ❑ Limited scholarships are available; however, we recommend that you ask your Knights of Columbus, pastor, parish pro-life group or other parishioners to sponsor the youth for \$50 per student. Youth ministers attending with their volunteering youth will receive the student discount.
- ❑ Registration is due March 25th and should be mailed, faxed or e-mailed to the CPLC according to the instructions on the registration form after you have called Jacquelyn Smith to indicate that you are interested in having your youth volunteer. Your registration must include the name of each person attending.
- ❑ Mark on the registration form that they are youth volunteers and be sure to list the adult contact.
- ❑ Each youth, middle or high school, must complete a general Catholic Pro-Life Committee release form.
- ❑ CPLC release forms may be mailed with the registration or brought to the event.
- ❑ Early shift volunteers should arrive for set-up wearing casual clothes.
- ❑ Youth For Life and the CPLC are not responsible for youth between the hours of 12:30 and 4:00 p.m.
- ❑ High school volunteers should arrive wearing "Sunday Best." "Sunday Best" means slacks and a button-down shirt for the young men and dresses or skirt and blouse for the young ladies. Short skirts or strapless outfits are not appropriate. Ladies should bring a sweater because it tends to be cold.
- ❑ If a registered youth is unable to attend, they must find a substitute. If they do not attend and do not find a substitute and have received a scholarship, they will need to reimburse the CPLC for the cost of their ticket.
