PLANO (Sat. Sept 26th)

John Paul II HS will be the Site of the Plano Hike this year. Updated forms with information will be made available as soon as possible. Please consult the website for details and updates.

DALLAS (Sat. Sept 26th)

The Hike for Life returns to White Rock Lake! Directions to the site will be listed on later versions of this sheet. Please consult the Website for updates.

WAXAHACHIE (Sat. Oct 3rd)

The Waxahachie Creek Hike & Bike Trail is a paved trail that runs from Lion's Park to Getzender Park finishing along scenic Waxahachie Creek.

From I-35E exit 287 Business and go east.

**Go to first red light (Grand Ave) and turn right (going south)
Travel for 2 blocks to the Waxahachie Hike and Bike Trail.**

GARLAND (Sat. Oct 3rd)

Audubon Park is a paved trail located at 342 W. Oates Rd., Garland, Texas winding through wooded areas and past beautiful creek beds. **From I-635 exit Oates road and turn to go north. From the 635/Oates intersection the Hike will be 2 miles on your right.**

IRVING (Sat. Oct 3rd)

Campion Trails is a paved trail that runs through various parks and along parts of the Trinity River. **From Spur 348 (Northwest Hwy) turn and go north onto O'Connor Road. Look for the Gateway to Campion Trails "Lions". The Hike starting Gate will be close by**

McKINNEY (Sat. Oct 3rd)

Erwin Park off of 380 in McKinney. It is a non-paved, but improved surface that has lots of shade. **From US-75 take Hwy 380 west. Turn right on FM 1461 and continue 1 mile. At CR 164 turn right and continue 3/10th mile until you get to CR 1006. Turn left on CR 1006 and you will see the park entrance. Go to the north end of park and you'll see Hilltop Pavilion**

Richardson (Sat. Oct 3rd)

Breckinridge Park is a paved trail that runs through various parks and along ponds and streams. **Located just south of the Renner Rd and Brand intersection. Once on Brand go to parking lot "C" to the pavilion.**

Be sure to include the organization (youth group, church, school etc.) you represent. This will enable your organization to receive credit towards awards, which will be presented after the HIKE. Also, this will allow HIKE officials to contact your organizational representative.
