Activity for April 2010

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 53 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 39 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 175 turnaways, 135 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,453. Accepted SWC literature: 16.52%. Accepted aftercare literature: 33.82%. Total coverage at all centers: 96.63%.
- 293 people attended Good Friday Stations of the Cross at Southwestern on April 2nd
- 125 attended the Quarterly Mass and Rosary Procession from St. Jude, Allen, to Northpark abortion center on April 17th

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Caryn Stevens

- Received a total of 12 calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, 7 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline and 14 emails through www.racheldallas.org for information on help and healing and the ministry.
- Caryn Stevens and Rachel Assistant Fonda Lash were interviewed on KATH 910 FM, Guadalupe Radio Network, in Dallas on post-abortion grief and recovery, and upcoming events.
- Caryn Stevens co-taught a Rachel's Vineyard Retreat™ workshop at the April 15-18 Operation Outcry National Conference entitled "Hope for Life 2010" and participated in a panel discussion on advertising the ministry to churches, schools and the community.
