Activity for January 2009

Convert-to-Life - Antoinette Wilson

- 28 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers (Includes 1 reported by Love Your Neighbor Dallas); 13 hopeful turnaways. Total for 2009: 28 turnaways, 13 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,457; accepted SWC literature: 37.27%; accepted aftercare literature: 6.86%. CTL coverage at all centers during killing hours: 100%.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Caryn Stevens

- Received a total of 10 calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, 13 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline and 12 emails through www.racheldallas.org for information on help and healing and the ministry.
- Continued helping with the planning and preparation for the Rachel's Vineyard Regional Training Conference to be held in Fort Worth in May 2009.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 7 babies born to Gabriel moms
- 2 moms paired with Gabriel Angels
- 103 BABY-DUE calls received at the White Rose Women's Center
- Spiritual counseling expands to Tuesdays and Fridays at the Angels Clinic
- Held training # 39 at St. Francis Anglican Church, Dallas

- Worked on FOCA Postcard Campaign with Parish Coordinators.

- Continued with preparations for Pure Reality event on February 8
