As a speaker, he has built a reputation as a motivator who speaks on overcoming seemingly impossible challenges by setting goals and working to achieve them.

Curtis Stephan, who is director of music and liturgy for St. Ann Catholic Church in Coppell, has leapfrogged from promising young songwriter to one of the most productive forces in liturgical music today.



Since committing his life to serving the Gospel through music, Curtis has published five solo collections, Curtis travels the world presenting liturgical training and inspirational music, witnessing to all ages through workshops, retreats, missions, conferences, youth rallies and liturgies.
