- ✚ Youth fees must be paid at time of registration to reserve your space.
- ✚ You may pay online or checks should be made payable to the Catholic Pro-Life Committee or CPLC.
- ✚ Full refunds until June 13th. No refunds one week prior to camp.
- ✚ Registration packets will be mailed 2-3 weeks prior to camp and all information will be available online at that time.
- ✚ Early registration for both sessions is due June 13th. After June 13th, the price will increase. Please call for availability.
- ✚ Jr. Staff and Chaperone applications must include proof of Safe Environment clearance from your diocese. Applications for Jr. Staff are due June 6th. Applications for Chaperones are due June 13th.
