	Since Project Gabriel began in Dallas over seventeen years ago, presenting adoption has been part of our services to our pregnant mothers. Adoption is a loving parenting option that is very different than it was even ten years ago. Today through <i>open</i> adoption, birth mothers are able to create a customized and unique plan, hand-pick an adoptive family, correspond with them through letters and pictures, and generally stay connected as the child grows.	community! Because of the large number of Hispanic clients we serve, Project Gabriel always welcomes bilingual angels. And for those bilingual speakers who are more comfortable communicating in Spanish, we also offer a training in Spanish. In May, our Gabriel Angel Coordinator Ingrid Meyer and Director of Spanish Ministry Aurora Tinajero conducted our second annual Spanish training for 21 would-be Angels. We plan to offer one Spanish training and two English trainings per year. The next English training is scheduled for August 23 and 30.
