THE RULES

As we commemorate the 40th anniversary of the tragic *Roe v. Wade* Supreme Court decision, reflect on the effect of 40 years of abortion has had on our society and how you plan to be a part of its abolition.

- ♥ Write a 400-word essay answering how 40 years of abortion has affected our society and how you plan to be a part of its abolition.
- One full scholarship to the 2013 March for Life will be awarded to the best overall essay.
 Second place is \$100 towards the trip fee, and third place is \$50 towards the trip fee.
- The contest is open to students in grades 9 through 12.
- The essay should be typed, double spaced, and in size 12 Times New Roman or similar font.
- ✤ Short essays under 350 words and long essays over 400 will not be eligible.
- Essays are due no later than November 12th by 8:00 p.m. Entries may be submitted <u>online</u> <u>only</u>.
- ✤ Grammar and spelling are important and may determine the difference between 1st place and runner up.
- Submit your essay online at prolifedallas.org/dcmarch.
- Do not include your name or anything that might identify you within your essay. (For example, instead of saying, "I'm the president of the pro-life club at John Smith High School," just say that you're the president of your school pro-life club.)
- \clubsuit Your essay will be judged by a panel of judges that will not know the author of the essay.
- \clubsuit Contest results will be announced November 26th.
