Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 34 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 15 hopefuls. YTD: 118 turnaways, 36 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,339; accepted SWC literature: 7.47%; accepted healing literature: 25.53%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Staffed table displays at Richland and Collin County colleges and met with 100+ students.
- Worked on revising sidewalk counseling literature.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 4 calls on English helpline, 12 on Spanish helpline, 3 on Joseph line; plus 3 Rachel e-mails and 3 Joseph e-mails.
- Held Rachel's Retreat Reunion for Spanish graduates and initiated a 10-week Bible study for all graduates of retreat.
- Offered an abortion-healing training to sidewalk counselors.
- Project Joseph team exhibited at N. TX Catholic Men's Conference and presented to 33 people.
- Continued planning Year of Mercy events.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 43 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center. YTD: 250
- 5 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 4 paired with Angel, 1 baby born to Gabriel Mom. YTD: 24 referrals, 8 pairings, 9 births
- Held GEMS classes on Sexual Integrity and Healthy Relationships for 21 moms total.
- Gabriel mom/GEMS candidate Danielle Vibila featured in annual ministry video.
- Continued holding Mujer con Valor classes.

- Hosted pro-life hour at Guadalupe Radio's Spring Radiothon and spoke on the dignity of human life
- Met with Latinos por la Vida to discuss future events and partnership.
