Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 31 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 14 hopefuls. YTD turnaways: 140; hopefuls: 54.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,732 accepted SWC literature: 8.6%; accepted healing literature: 18.05%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Supported annual Pro-Life Good Friday Stations of the Cross at Southwestern abortion facility.
- Met with Pastor at Antioch Fellowship Baptist Church and attended Human Coalition event.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 4 calls on English helpline, 14 on Spanish helpline, 1 on Joseph line; plus 5 Rachel e-mails and 1 Joseph e-mail.
- Presented on post-abortion healing to White Rose Magdalen Group, held Spanish Rachel Retreat Reunion, hosted presentation by Fr. Daza for Rachel and Joseph Graduates.
- Exhibited Project Joseph at the North Texas Catholic Men's Conference.
- Continued support of ministry in Oklahoma and preparations for upcoming clergy training.

Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 64 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline; YTD: 228.
- 3 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 8 babies born to Gabriel Moms; YTD: 19 referrals, 7 pairings, 18 births.
- Held Angel Training (8 attended); GEMS classes on Sexual Integrity (14 moms) and Domestic Violence (11 moms); and Mujer con Valor classes.
- Assisted Gabriel moms with adoption option and legal issues.
