Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 39 women turned away from the four Dallas abortion centers; 12 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 410 turnaways, 184 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,690; accepted SWC literature: 6.80%; accepted aftercare literature: 31.11%. Total coverage at all centers: 99%.
- Gave bilingual sidewalk counseling training to 25 people at St. Elizabeth of Hungary, Dallas.
- Held meeting for all sidewalk counselors to prepare for upcoming 40 Days for Life-Dallas Vigil outside the newly opened Planned Parenthood mega facility.
- Hired new bilingual sidewalk counselor Antonio
 Estrada to work outside the new Planned Parenthood.

- Received 6 calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, 10 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline, and 3 e-mails to healing@racheldallas.org / sanacion@racheldallas.org.
- Presented on Abortion AfterCare-Healing at Nuestra Señora de Pilar Masses and to The Magdalen Group at White Rose Women's Center.
- Held Rachel's Vineyard™ retreat #52 in English with 10 people attending; hosted support groups.
- Hired part-time bilingual Project Joseph Coordinator Mr. Casey Aranda.
- Held the annual Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon for all volunteers serving The Rachel Ministries.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 77 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center (YTD: 670).
- Three moms were referred to Project Gabriel and two were paired with an Angel (YTD: 32 referrals; 16 pairings).
- One baby was born to a Gabriel mom (YTD: 13 births).
- Trained and commissioned 7 Gabriel Angels at Immaculate Conception, Grand Prairie.
- Finalized the fall GEMS class schedule and reviewed graduation candidates.
- Met with representatives from The Bella House and Maggie's Place re: housing need for mothers.

Spanish Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Gave an abortion talk for 300 young adults from Good Shepherd Catholic Parish and presented The Five Non-Negotiables with Dr. Martha Garza at St. Mark, Plano for 60 people.
- Hosted and trained Congreso participant and former United Nations employee working on pro-life program in Dominican Republic.
- Hosted two pro-life hours for the Guadalupe Radio summer radiothon.

Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt
