## Activity for August 2016

#### Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 43 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 18 hopefuls. YTD: 300 turnaways, 100 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,920; accepted SWC literature: 5.68%; accepted healing literature: 34.78%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Held Sidewalk Counselor and Prayer Partner Appreciation Dinner.
- Represented Dallas frontline ministry at TX Pro-Life Leadership Meeting.

#### Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Prepared for and held first of 3 Render unto Caesar radio programs presenting on life issues and civic participation.
- Attended USCCB Pro-Life Diocesan Leadership Conference, Theology of the Body Evangelization Team Banquet, Remembrance Mass for Children and Texas Pro-Life Leadership Meeting.
- Presented at Parish Pro-Life Coordinators Meeting.

- Held Rachel's Vineyard Retreat # 36 in Spanish for 11 people and #58 in English for 12 people, and facilitated support group for Spanish grads.
- Promoted and coordinated annual Remembrance Mass for Children with Prayer Ministry.
- Presented on suicide ideation to Convert-to-Life Ministry and on healing to White Rose Magdalene group and to parish pro-life coordinators.

#### Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- 5 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 2 paired with Angel, 2 babies born to Gabriel Mom. YTD: 58 referrals, 26 pairings, 15 births
- Held training and commissioned 13 new Gabriel Angels.
- Gave interview on Celebrando la Vida re: new Mujer de Valor project for Spanishspeaking moms.

#### Speakers Bureau - Sheree Havlik

- Gave 5 presentations to 50 adults on How to Help Prevent Suicide, the Speakers Bureau, Faithful Citizenship, and What To You Do When the Pregnancy Test Comes Back Negative at St. Rita, Holy Family, and CPLC office.
