- 11 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 2 hopefuls. YTD totals: 335 turnaways; 179 hopefuls. Abortion clients at all facilities: 863; accepted SWC literature: 10.76%; accepted healing literature: 25%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Gave presentation to Our Lady of Lebanon Maronite Youth Group in Lewisville.
- Planned 2016 Quarterly Masses and Processions with Prayer Ministry.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 2 calls on English helpline, 5 on Spanish helpline; plus 9 Rachel e-mails.
- Offered a training on procedures for counseling suicide ideation and crisis calls.
- Held Christmas gathering for Spanishspeaking Rachel and Joseph teams.
- Continued planning Year of Mercy retreats, trainings and gatherings of 2016.
- Presented ministry report to the CPLC staff and board of directors.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 31 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center. YTD total: 703.
- 2 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 1 paired with Angel; 2 babies born to Project Gabriel Moms. YTD totals: 59 referrals, 26 pairings, 19 births.
- Held GEMS classes: Forgiveness and Grace and Spirituality and annual GEMS Christmas party with 19 attending, and planned for GEMS Spring Semester.
- Helped 3 moms with financial and material needs.
