Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 29 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 22 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 73 turnaways, 38 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,044. Accepted SWC literature: 20.7%. Accepted aftercare literature: 28.91%. Total coverage at all centers: 85.42%.
- On February 20 we had our first Bilingual SWC training, held at St. Edward Parish. We had a total attendance of 68; 53 were Spanish-speaking and 15 English.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Caryn Stevens

- Received a total of 11 calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, 7 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline and 15 emails through www.racheldallas.org for information on help and healing and the ministry.
- Held a reunion for the graduates of the 17th Rachel's Vineyard RetreatTM in Spanish.
- Attended the 3rd Annual Texas Students for Life Conference held at Texas A & M University in Bryan/College Station on February 27th. AAC-H and post-abortion literature, materials and information were offered at the conference.
