

CPLC Ministry Update

Activity for February 2012

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 46 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 51 hopeful turnaways; YTD Totals: 93 turnaways, 119 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,817; accepted SWC literature: 18.82%; accepted aftercare literature: 43.24%. Total coverage at all centers: 97%.
- Attended Right to Life of Southeast Texas reception, gave Sidewalk Counseling Training and spoke at the 40 Days for Life rally at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Beaumont, TX.
- Staffed the CPLC table at the 40 Days For Life-McKinney Kickoff Rally.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 3 calls on 214-544-CARE helpline, approximately 12 calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline, and 9 emails through website for information on help, healing and the ministry.
- Presented The Rachel Ministries at a Gabriel Angel Training at St. Pius X and at a Birth Choice volunteer training.
- Completed work on video production scheduled to be filmed in March in English and Spanish.
- Held Spanish Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat with 14 in attendance and English Retreat Reunion.

- 118 calls received on 972-BABY-DUE hotline, answered at White Rose Women's Center
- Four referrals and two mothers paired with Gabriel Angels
- Two babies born to Gabriel moms
- Trained and commissioned 17 new Gabriel Angels at St. Pius X.
- Finalized GEMS spring schedule and Education Team assignments.
