# **CPLC Ministry Update**

## Activity for February 2016

## Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 26 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 2 hopefuls. YTD: 54 turnaways, 11 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,164; accepted SWC literature: 11.94%; accepted healing literature: 20%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Staffed table with Birth Choice and spoke to 165 students at Richland College.

#### Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 17 calls on English helpline, 22 on Spanish helpline, 2 on Joseph line; plus 10 Rachel e-mails and 1 Joseph e-mails.
- Presented at Gabriel Angel training and Parish Pro-Life Coordinators meeting, and gave radio interview re: ministry and Year of Mercy.
- Attended USCCB Project Rachel Conference and presented on "Ministering to Men."
- Trained 11 team members on the effects of the trauma of abortion on the brain.
- Continued planning Year of Mercy events.

## Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 92 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center.
   YTD: 137
- 6 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 1 paired with Angel; 5 babies born to Project Gabriel Moms. YTD: 13 referrals, 3 pairings, 7 births.
- Trained and commissioned 9 new Gabriel Angels.
- Held 2 GEMS classes, Christian Parenting and Abortion Loss, with 13 moms and 4 Angels.
- Presented Project Gabriel in Colombia.
- Assisted 6 moms with financial/material resources.

- Presented on Respect Life to 23 teens at a
   Quinceañera Retreat; 15 young adults at St. Luke,
   Irving; 38 young adults at Good Shepherd,
