

# CPLC Ministry Update

## Activity for January 2018

### ***Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood***

- **22 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 15 hopeful turnaways; YTD Totals: 22 turnaways, 15 hopefuls.**
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,720. Accepted SWC literature: 14.42%. Accepted aftercare literature: 25.89%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%
- Attended *Upstander Speaker Series: Sex Trafficking in North Texas at the Unity of Dallas.*

### ***Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann***

- Received 13 calls on English and Spanish helpline, 6 Rachel emails, and 2 Joseph emails.
- Attended the Hope for the Heart two-day conference titled “The Abortion Dilemma.”
- **Interviewed by Guadalupe Radio Network and Cristo Rey Radio regarding post-abortion pain and healing.**
- Met with Formación en la Fe to plan future trainings.
- Prepared for seminarian pro-life training.

### ***Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer***

- 58 calls received on 972-BABY-DUE helpline. YTD: 58.
- 2 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 3 paired with Angels; 3 babies born.
- Presented GEMS Finance class to 9 Gabriel Moms.
- **Held Gabriel Angel training session commissioning 4 new Angels.**
- Attended quarterly Pro-Life Apostolate meeting and held Project Gabriel Staff Meeting.

### ***Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero***

- **Presented on abortion to teens and parents of confirmation candidates, and on the dignity of the human person at Nuestra Señora del Pilar; on pornography at St. Michael, McKinney; and on abortion at St. Francis in Grapevine.**
- Hired new Hispanic Pastoral Education Coordinator, Omar Aguilar.
- Hosted radio program on the dangers of Birth Control on Celebrando la Vida.

### ***Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt***
