## Activity for July 2012

#### Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 64 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 31 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 410 turnaways, 291 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 2,024; accepted SWC literature: 19.37%; accepted aftercare literature: 21.31%. Total coverage at all centers: 97%.
- Gave Sidewalk Counseling Trainings in Bossier City and Shreveport, Louisiana, and met with several Protestant pro-life leaders at Dallas Downtown Pregnancy Center.
- Organized the Quarterly Rosary Procession to the Planned Parenthood abortion center in Dallas.
- Attended National Sidewalk Counseling Symposium.

#### Spanish Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Prepared for presentation and panel discussion at the upcoming USCCB Pro-Life Directors Conference in Anaheim, CA.
- Gave a Responsible Voting Seminar at Good Shepherd, Garland.
- Met with potential volunteers for Spanish Speakers Bureau.

- Finalized planning and preparations for 10th Annual Pro-Life Boot Camp, and held Sessions 1 and II, June 29-July 1 and July 26-31.
- Held a YFL Leadership Council Meeting.
- Launched the "Not-So-Underground Railroad" to commemorate the 15th anniversary of YFL.

- Began preparations for August Gabriel Angel Training including participants from the Diocese of Fort Worth.
