Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 65 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 23 hopefuls. YTD: 257 turnaways, 82 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,030; accepted SWC literature: 21.02%; accepted healing literature: 50%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Held ecumenical sidewalk counseling training at Gaston Oaks Baptist Church and onsite at Southwestern abortion facility.
- Completed new sidewalk counseling literature.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Met with Omar Aguilar, Project Manager for Latinos por la Vida, on national model for Hispanic Outreach.
- Assisted with presentation of bilingual Parish Coordination Meeting.
- Featured parish leader, Patricia Hernandez, on weekly radio show "Celebrando la Vida" to share her witness as to how pro-life ministry has impacted her parish.

Youth For Life - Jacquelyn Smith

- Promoted and prepared for 2016 Boot Camp.
- Held 14th Annual Pro-Life Boot Camp attended by 40 high school youth from 26 parishes and 5 dioceses, plus 7 junior staff (college students) and 16 chaperones / volunteers.
- Planned for 2016/17 school year activities.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 9 calls on English helpline, 21 on Spanish helpline, 2 on Joseph line; plus 3 Rachel e-mails and 9 Joseph e-mails.
- Held new Project Joseph Breakfast and Retreat no. 3 in English with 6 men attending.
- Interviewed by Guadalupe Radio Network re: post-abortion healing and retreats in English and Spanish.
- Offered training for Rachel and Joseph Retreat teams.

Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- Continued preparation for fall 40 Days for Life vigil at Planned Parenthood abortion facility.
- Held Summer Mass and Rosary Procession, with approximately 180 attending Mass at Nuestra Señora del Pilar and over 220 praying the rosary at Planned Parenthood.
- Continued collaboration with Healing after Abortion Ministry on Remembrance Mass.
- Attended National 40 Days for Life Symposium.
- Circulated prayer reflections to CPLC staff.
- Continued research of ecumenical contacts.

- Researched Congressional investigative panel's interim report on Planned Parenthood practices.
- Planned for Render unto Caesar Election-Year Radio Series and Webcast.
- Participated in conference calls with partners regarding 2017 North Texas March for Life.
- Ongoing tracking of government and candidate responses to life issues.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 42 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center. YTD: 402
- 4 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 1 paired with Angel, 1 baby born to Gabriel Mom. YTD: 53 referrals, 24 pairings, 13 births
- Gave a talk to 20 people at Our Lady of Czestochowa in Mexico City on 5 Non-Negotiables.
- Promoted and planned for August Gabriel Angel Training and GEMS Fall Semester.
