Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 16 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 12 hopefuls. YTD totals: 219 turnaways; 127 hopefuls. Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,587; accepted SWC literature: 16.11%; accepted aftercare literature: 20.45%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Began planning Closing Memorial Service outside the Routh Street abortion facility.
- Gave a sidewalk counseling training at Trinity Family Church, Forney, Texas.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Co-sponsored Theology of the Body Conference with the Natural Family Planning Center of Dallas at Immaculate Conception Parish with 200 in attendance.
- Participated in the CPLC Day of Reflection.
- Ministry Assistant Patricia Vasquez and sidewalk counselor Felis Enriquez gave a sidewalk counseling training in Spanish in San Jose, California, with 51 in attendance.

- Continued promotion of Pro-Life Boot Camp.
