Activity for June 2016

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 68 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 9 hopefuls. YTD: 186 turnaways, 59 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,373; accepted SWC literature: 10.9%; accepted healing literature: 19.54%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Held a Sidewalk Counseling Training in Spanish at Nuestra Seňora Del Pilar.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 1 call on English helpline, 9 on Spanish helpline, 3 on Joseph line; plus 6 Rachel e-mails and 7 Joseph e-mails.
- Presented to Magdalene Group at White Rose Women's Center, to St. Mark prolife group in Spanish and after all Masses at St. Philip parish.
- Participated as breakout speaker for first ever Women's Pro-Life Conference.
- Interviewed by GRN on the topic of men and abortion.
- Continued planning Year of Mercy events.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 68 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center. YTD: 360
- 19 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 12 paired with Angel, 2 babies born to Gabriel Mom. YTD: 49 referrals, 23 pairings, 12 births
- Held GEMS class ("Pre & Post-Natal Care and Nutrition" for 5 moms, 4 coaches) and *Mujer con* Valor class for Spanish-speaking moms.
- Trained and commissioned 8 Spanish-speaking Gabriel Angels.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Facilitated simultaneous translation and Spanish speaking track of first-ever Pro-Life Women's Conference and presented "How to get involved" in Spanish at the conference.
- Met with parishioners of Saint Augustine, Good Shepherd and Mary Immaculate to plan presentations on life issues, Faithful Citizenship and Theology of the Body.
- Posted live feed of "Celebrando la Vida" radio show reaching over 400 viewers and planned radio interviews of CPLC Ministry Directors.

Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- Began planning 40 Days for Life-Dallas vigil;
 33% of days covered by prayer volunteers.
- Promoted and planned July Summer Mass and Rosary for Life and August Remembrance Mass for Children with Convert-to-Life, Healing after Abortion and Hispanic Pastoral Ministries.
- Coordinated Day of Reflection at St. Monica for approximately 44 staff and volunteers.
- Prepared and circulated prayer reflections to CPLC staff.

Speakers Bureau - Sheree Havlik

- Gave 6 presentations to 674 adults on Abortion & Post-Abortion Healing and How to Get Involved in the Pro-Life Movement at Pro-Life Women's Conference; Pro-Life Politics; and Five Non-Negotiables at Our Lady of Czestochowa Parish in Mexico.
- 2015/16 fiscal year summary statistics:
 - Adults: 93 presentations to 10,457 people;
