

# CPLC Ministry Update

## Activity for June 2017

### ***Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood***

- **24 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 10 hopefuls. YTD turnaways: 189; hopefuls: 75.**
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,421; accepted SWC literature: 8.44%; accepted healing literature: 26.53%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Held bilingual sidewalk counseling training at St. Mark, Plano.
- Met with Sister Yolanda at Mount St. Michael regarding pregnancy resource center needs.

### ***Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann***

- Received 7 calls on English helpline, 10 on Spanish helpline, 2 on Joseph line; plus 3 Rachel e-mails and 3 Joseph e-mails.
- **Held Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat #39 and reunion in Spanish, Retreat #61 and reunion in English, and annual Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon for ministry team.**
- Continued planning of clergy training, ambo presentations, team trainings and assistance of healing ministry in Oklahoma.
- Planned interview on Guadalupe Radio.

### ***Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer***

- 72 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline. YTD: 378.
- 3 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 2 paired with Angels; 3 babies born. YTD: 27 referrals, 13 pairings; 24 births.
- **Held GEMS class on prayer with 9 Gabriel Moms attending and team meeting to plan 10th Anniversary Celebration.**
- Met with Sister Yolanda at Mount St. Michael regarding potential space.

### ***Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero***

- Presented on Chastity to youth group at St. Monica Catholic Church.
- **Continued planning, promoting and selling tickets to Bella Vida Dinner.**
- Attended Catholic Pro-Life Committee's Day of Reflection for staff and volunteers.
- Met with pro-life partners to plan 2018 North Texas March for Life Events.

### ***Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt***

- Began planning, promoting and opened sign-ups for Fall 40 Days for Life vigil outside Southwestern abortion facility.
- **Organized Day of Reflection for staff and volunteers at St. Joseph Catholic Church.**
- Continued preparing for Summer Mass and Rosary for Life in July, Remembrance Mass for Children in August, and Respect Life Mass in October.
- Circulated prayer reflections to CPLC staff.
- Continued research of ecumenical contacts.

### ***Speakers Bureau - Sheree Havlik***

- Gave 2 presentations to 50 adults on a variety of topics, including Sexuality, Morality, Intimacy, Pro-life, Abortion, Contraception, NFP, and IVF at the Diocesan Marriage Preparation Program.
- Prepared goals and budget for 2017-2018.
- **Year-end statistics for 2016-2017 fiscal/school year:**
  - **140 presentations to 4012 students, and**
  - **72 presentations to 2910 adults.**

### ***Youth For Life - Jacquelyn Smith***

- Promoted, planned and managed registrations for Pro-Life Boot Camp, including GRN interview.
- Selected Jr. Staff and Chaperones for Boot Camp.
