

CPLC Ministry Update

Activity for June 2018

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- **35 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities, 11 hopeful turnaways; YTD totals: 233 turnaways, 86 hopefuls.**
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,530. Accepted SWC literature: 12.22%. Accepted aftercare literature: 28.42. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Hosted sidewalk counseling trainings in English and Spanish.
- Presented at state pro-life leaders meeting.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 2 calls to the English Rachel helpline, 10 calls to the Spanish Rachel helpline, and 2 calls to Project Joseph; 2 English Rachel emails, 2 Spanish emails and 3 Joseph emails received.
- Presented at In My Shoes Maternity Home.
- **Facilitated a successful Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat in Spanish for 15 people, and annual Project Joseph® Day of Healing for 6 men.**
- Continued training with Houston Rachel Team to prepare for their first Spanish retreat.

Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- **4 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 4 paired with Angels; 3 babies born. YTD: 40 referrals, 21 paired moms, 13 babies born.**
- Coordinated GEMS class on Prayer: 13 GEMS moms attended and 5 staff & volunteers.
- Spoke at St. Thomas Aquinas Church to promote Disciples for Life program.
- Attended Day of Reflection and Renewal.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Conducted a site visit with the Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes parish to discuss Parish Coordination Meeting and future pro-life efforts in parish.
- **Continued planning and promoting “New Battle Lines for Life” dual-track Conference on *Humanae Vitae* and life issues.**
- Hosted radio program dedicated to highlight sidewalk counseling ministry.

Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- Organized Day of Reflection for board, staff and volunteers at St. Joseph Catholic Church.
- **Presented Disciples for Life at St. Thomas Aquinas parish to about 3,000 parishioners and arranged for presentation to 1,600 parishioners at Prince of Peace Catholic Church in Plano.**
- Coordinating July Summer Mass/Rosary with Convert-to-Life ministry and St. Patrick's staff.
- Opened scheduling for Dallas 40 Days for Life at South Dallas Planned Parenthood abortion facility.

- Gave 1 presentation to 4 adults on Post-Abortion Healing at In My Shoes Maternity Home.
- Continued development and completed the initial content for the “When They Say . . .” website for teens.
- **End-of-School-Year Presentation Stats:**
 - ◆ **Youth: 141 presentations to 6,415 students**
 - ◆ **Adults: 76 presentations to 2,908 adults.**

Youth For Life - Jacquelyn Smith

- Created digital promotions for Boot Camp 2018.
- Continued planning for first-ever Pro-Life Day Camp - 4 days.
- **Planned & exhibited at Steubenville Lone Star Youth Conference: witnessed to 4,500 youth/adults and promoted upcoming pro-life events.**
