Activity for March 2012

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 70 Women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 43 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 163 turnaways, 162 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 2,326. Accepted SWC literature: 21.37%; accepted aftercare literature: 32.81%. Total coverage at all centers: 97%.
- Conducted two trainings in Corpus Christi for local STOPP group and Hope House Pregnancy Center.
- Met with Pastors Raul and Paola Villegas of Iglesia Evangelica Cristo Vive regarding prayer support.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received a total of six calls on the 214-544-CARE helpline, four calls on the 972-679-4760 Spanish helpline, and three English and one Spanish email through racheldallas.org.
- Presented The Rachel Ministries for Project Life at St. Joseph, Richardson; addressed student group at UTD.
- RV Spanish/English video production filmed for use on TV and through social media.
- Coordinated participation of priests and volunteer mental health professionals for TheEstherCall.
- RV Spanish retreatants and team had a successful Rachel's Vineyard reunion.
