## Activity for March 2017

## Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 31 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 10 hopefuls. YTD turnaways: 109; hopefuls: 40.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 2,406 accepted SWC literature: 8.6%; accepted healing literature: 59.10%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Met with Pastor at South Gate Fellowship Church, Duncanville.
- Presented training by Mosaic Family Services to counselors on human trafficking.

## Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 3 calls on English helpline, 12 on Spanish helpline, 4 on Joseph line; plus 6 Rachel e-mails and 1 Joseph e-mail.
- Held Rachel's Vineyard Retreat #60 in English and #38 in Spanish with 16 people attending, including 4 retreatants from Tulsa, OK.
- Conducted team training on mental health of an abortionist; presented talk on "Guilt and Mercy" by Fr. Carlos for Spanish-speaking graduates; and gave interview re: Project Joseph for *Now and at the Hour* magazine.
- Continued planning 2017 clergy seminar.

## Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 48 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline; YTD: 164.
- 5 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 2 paired with Angels; 1 baby born to Gabriel Mom; YTD: 16 referrals, 7 pairings, 10 births.
- Held Grow in Gabriel (5 Angels); GEMS classes on Nutrition (9 moms) and Theology of the Body (8 moms); and Mujer con Valor (3 moms).
- Met with Gabriel Mom re: adoption option and facilitated filming of video testimonial.
- Met with GEMS team and continued developing client-assistance protocols.

#### Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Met with Latinos por la Vida to discuss collaboration.
- Continued planning Bella Vida benefit.
- Gave talk on Chastity at Good Shepherd parish retreat.
- Hosted Celebrando la Vida weekly radio show, including interview of former Planned Parenthood Manager Ramona Treviño.
- Facilitated bilingual promotions of Bishop's Pro-Life Dinner.

- Continued planning 2017 prayer events, including Good Friday Stations of the Cross, Summer Mass and Rosary, Remembrance Mass, and Respect Life Mass.
- Prepared and circulated prayer reflections to CPLC staff.
- Continued research of ecumenical contacts.
