

CPLC Ministry Update

Activity for March 2018

Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- **38 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities plus 18 hopeful turnaways; YTD Totals: 93 turnaways, 41 hopefuls.**
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,149. Accepted SWC literature: 18.28%. Accepted aftercare literature: 20.69. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Met with Pastor Tommy Brown, The New Mount Zion Baptist Church, Dallas.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 4 calls and 9 emails to the English helpline, 11 calls and 1 email to the Spanish helpline, 3 calls and 1 email to Project Joseph.
- **Presented in English & Spanish to Magdalene group at White Rose, at 40 Days for Life-Plano rally and to Familia Educadora en la Fe, and hosted presentation on Spiritual Boundaries for pro-life and healing ministries.**
- Interviewed by Guadalupe Radio Network.
- Hosted volunteer appreciation breakfast.
- Attended Hope Ctr. presentation on sexual assault.

Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 61 calls received on 972-BABY-DUE helpline. YTD: 171.
- 5 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 3 paired with Angels; 4 babies born. YTD: 18 referrals, 11 pairings, 7 babies born.
- **Held GEMS classes on Domestic Violence for 18 moms and Contraception (new) for 12 moms.**
- Presented Boundaries talk at Grow in Gabriel training for Gabriel Angels with 12 attending.
- Visited Birth Choice to meet with moms and staff, and met with Nursing Family Partnership at Parkland and with St. Ann pro-life group re: collaboration.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Presented talk on Euthanasia at St. Mark Parish, Plano.
- Met with St. Ann Pro-Life Group to assist with organization and collaboration with CPLC.
- **Assisted with Good Friday Prayer Service in Spanish at Planned Parenthood.**
- Helped promote Bishop's Pro-Life Dinner.
- Hosted weekly Celebrando la Vida radio program.

Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- **Introduced new Gospel of Life Disciples program at St. Michael the Archangel - Garland to about 2,300 parishioners, and gave presentations on CPLC mission and ministries to 205 people at St. Peter the Apostle.**
- Coordinated Good Friday Stations of the Cross at Southwestern abortion facility & Planned Parenthood with more than 500 participants.
