- 55 women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 45 hopeful turnaways. YTD: 351 turnaways, 210 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,540. Accepted SWC literature: 17.08%; accepted aftercare literature: 32.5%. Total coverage at all centers: 100%.
- Met with Lieutenants Ham and Andrews of the Dallas Police Department on CPLC presence at Robinson's and Southwestern abortion centers.
