- 54 Women turned away from the five Dallas abortion centers; 29 hopeful turnaways. YTD totals: 260 turnaways, 236 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 2,213; accepted SWC literature: 16.63%; accepted aftercare literature: 42.10%. Total coverage at all centers: 100%.
- Sidewalk Counseling Training was held at the Family Care Pregnancy Center with six people attending.
- Networked with the various churches in the area for prayer coverage of Planned Parenthood on second and fourth Saturdays of the month.
