Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 25 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 11 hopefuls. YTD turnaways: 165; hopefuls: 65.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,795; accepted SWC literature: 9.03%; accepted healing literature: 61.43%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Attended "Networking to Save Our Community" ecumenical event with speakers from Life Dynamics and pastors of local churches.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 7 calls on English helpline, 16 on Spanish helpline, 1 on Joseph line; plus 5 Rachel e-mails and 3 Joseph e-mail.
- Presented to Magdalene group of White Rose, Redemptoris Mater Seminary, parish pro-life coordinators, and at St. Joseph, Waxahachie.
- Interviewed by Guadalupe Radio Network.
- Continued assisting Oklahoma City with initiation of Spanish Rachel Retreats.
- Continued preparing for clergy training, ambo presentations, and team training for 2017.

Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 78 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline. YTD: 306
- 5 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 2 paired with Angels; 3 babies born. YTD: 24 referrals, 11 pairings; 21 births.
- Held 2nd session of Angel Training and Commissioning; GEMS class on Community Resources; and Mujer con Valor classes.
- Assisted Gabriel moms with practical needs and resource referrals.
