Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 45 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities, 25 hopeful turnaways; YTD totals: 180 turnaways, 75 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1598. Accepted SWC literature: 23.09%. Accepted aftercare literature: 40.79. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Gave a sidewalk counseling training in Tyler, TX.
- Hosted an ecumenical outreach luncheon for 20 people.

Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 8 calls and 4 emails to the English Rachel helpline, 3 calls to the Spanish Rachel helpline, 10 calls and 2 emails to Project Joseph.
- Presented on post-abortion healing to Thrive Pregnancy Resource Center, and pro-life curriculum to Redemptoris Mater Seminary.
- Continued training of Houston Rachel Retreat team in preparation of their first Rachel's VineyardTM Retreat in Spanish.

Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 12 Moms referred to Project Gabriel; 3 paired with Angels; 1 baby born. YTD: 36 referrals, 17, 2 babies born.
- Presented on Project Gabriel to the St. Ann Men's Club.
- Conducted Spanish Gabriel Angel training; commissioned 10 new Angels.
- Held GEMS classes on parenting and discipline for 12 Gabriel Moms and on community resources for 14 Gabriel Moms.
