# **CPLC Ministry Update**

# Activity for November 2016

#### Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 46 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 16 hopefuls. YTD: 422 turnaways, 137 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,518; accepted SWC literature: 14.56%; accepted healing literature: 19.23%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Spoke to over 170 students at Collin and Richland County Colleges.
- Assisted with 40 Days for Life campaign.

#### Healing after Abortion - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 12 calls on English helpline, 25 on Spanish helpline, 1 on Joseph line; plus 11 Rachel e-mails and 1 Joseph e-mail.
- Offered a Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat in English for 9 attendees and prepared for Retreat #37 in Spanish.
- Continued bible study for English graduates.
- Facilitated training session for ministry teams on Abortion Loss and Unresolved Grief and planned 2017 events.

## Project Gabriel - Ingrid Meyer

- 46 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline. YTD: 626
- 5 moms referred to Project Gabriel; 3 paired with Angel, 3 babies born to Gabriel Moms. YTD: 74 referrals, 32 pairings, 22 births
- Held GEMS classes on Adoption (20 moms attended with presentations by birth mothers and adoptive families and Mujer con Valor class on Learning to Discern.
- Held recognition ceremony at Christ Child Luncheon for 4 outstanding GEMS participants.

#### Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Supported 40 Days for Life campaign and bilingual Parish Pro-Life Coordinators meeting
- Hosted weekly Celebrando la Vida radio show, including breaking news radio show on abortion in Dallas.
- Held Pasos por la Vida with 2,000 in attendance at Mass, Eucharistic Procession, and Rally.
- Promoted and attended Euforia event for families at St. Monica Parish benefitting the ministries of the CPLC.

#### Prayer Ministry - Susan Platt

- Held closing hour of prayer and victory celebration for 40 Days for Life fall campaign, and gave parish report on campaign: 13 babies saved and 60 churches and organizations participated.
- Participated in webinar: "Abortion in Dallas." and initiated weekly prayer vigil at reopening Northpark abortion facility.
- Preparing for 2017 Roe Memorial Mass.
- Circulated prayer reflections to CPLC staff.
- Continued research of ecumenical contacts.
