Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 82 women turned away from the 5 Dallas abortion centers (including 2 calls to CPLC office); 76 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 654 turnaways, 498 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,647. Accepted SWC literature: 18.09%; accepted aftercare literature: 44.07%. Total coverage at all centers: 96%.
- Coordinated October 15 Respect Life Quarterly Mass celebrated by Fr. Josef Vollmer-König and Rosary Procession to the Southwestern late-term abortion center with Fr. Josef, Bishop Mark Seitz and Fr. Jim Kelleher; 40 Days for Life-Dallas Midway Rally and Youth Day held the same day.
