Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 20 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 5 hopefuls. YTD totals: 295 turnaways; 166 hopefuls. Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,159; accepted SWC literature: 11.65%; accepted aftercare literature: 11.65%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Spoke to 186 students from Collin and Richland College.
- Held Respect Life Month Rosary Procession to Southwestern abortion facility and supported 40 Days for Life 24/7 prayer vigil.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 15 calls on English helpline, 24 on Spanish helpline, and 8 on Project Joseph line; plus 9 Rachel e-mails and 3 Joseph e-mails.
- Interviewed by GRN radio station.
- Held Proyecto José #2 retreat in Spanish for 14 men and Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat #34 in Spanish for 14 people, including retreat graduate reunion, and prepared for upcoming Rachel's Vineyard™ Retreat in English.
- Presented post-abortion healing to 40 Spanishspeaking young adults at Good Shepherd parish.

- 49 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center.
 YTD total: 624
- 2 moms referred to Project Gabriel, 1 paired with Angel. YTD totals: 47 referrals, 20 pairings, and 9 births.
- Held two GEMS classes on Christian Parenting and Adoption with 22 moms attending.
- Met with Mater Filius re: future housing for Gabriel Moms.
- Helped 5 moms with financial and material needs.
