- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,467; accepted SWC literature: 8.93%; accepted healing literature: 52.17%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Exhibited and intersected with 95 students at Collin County College.
- Met with "Human Trafficking Division" in Austin
