- 29 women turned away from the two Dallas abortion facilities; 18 hopefuls. YTD: 329 turnaways, 118 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,910; accepted SWC literature: 7.9%; accepted healing literature: 14.55%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Exhibited and intersected with 160 students at Collin and Richland Colleges.
- Supported 40 Days for Life Fall campaign.

- Held GEMS classes on Celebrating Womanhood: Beauty Inside and Out with 10 moms and 4 coaches attending and provided Pre & Postnatal Care instruction for 1 mom with 2 coaches.
