 YTD turnaways: 266; hopefuls: 113.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,180; 12.71% accepted SWC literature: 21.43%; accepted healing literature: 27.27%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Exhibited at Collin County and Richland Community Colleges for more than 160 students.

Hispanic Pastoral Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Held first ever Bella Vida Dinner with 500 people in attendance.
- Coordinated filming and distribution of Dr. Polo's keynote presentation.
- Continued planning Pasos por la Vida on Saturday, November 4.
- Gave 5 talks on the pro-life issues to the parents in the religious education program at St. Edward Catholic Church.
