- © Keep the board interesting. Remember that people are more likely to read the board if it is organized, attractive, and updated.

Organize a Respect Life Week

- © Have a special speaker come in for the whole school
- © Sell Precious Feet pins and bumper stickers
- © Chalk the sidewalks with pro-life statistics
- © Mark every fourth chair in the cafeteria to symbolize those killed by abortion
- © Have pro-life prayers read every morning
