



PRAYER VIGIL GUIDELINES

Where can I legally park?

The Southwestern late-term abortion center is located at 8616 Greenville Avenue in the "Royal Creek Professional Park" complex. The best place to park is on Boundbrook Avenue. This is the first side street north of the intersection of Greenville Avenue and Royal Lane, on the west side of Greenville Avenue. See the Map & Directions for more parking options. Please do not park in the Royal Creek complex parking lot.

What do I do when I arrive?

- **Upon your arrival**, please sign the "Sign-in Sheet" in the "Vigil Box" with a blue top at the vigil site. Also, if you have not previously done so, please sign the "Statement of Peace" and put it in the red folder in the Vigil Box. You will also find literature and prayer books as well as other supplies that you may use during your vigil time.
- **If your vigil shift is after sundown**, at least one of the prayer volunteers should wear one of the reflective vests provided in the Vigil Box.
- **After signing in**, please remain in the strict discipline of prayer while standing on the public access sidewalk of the office complex. You are providing crucial spiritual and moral support for the sidewalk counselors, praying for the babies and for the conversion of heart of the abortionists, staff, and the abortion-bound parents. Even when sidewalk counselors are not present, prayer warriors are vital. Peaceful signs may be used, but please do not display any graphic images.
- **Before leaving**, be sure to collect all items you brought to the vigil site (including signs, chairs etc) and take them with you. We also welcome you to make additions to the prayer journal in the Vigil Box; some of these entries may be read anonymously at the Victory Celebration concluding the campaign.

Is everyone required to sign a Statement of Peace?

Yes! By signing the statement, each person is agreeing to maintain the peaceful presence that is key to the 40 Days for Life-Dallas Campaign.

Where can I legally stand?

There are three entrances into the office complex. You may stand in the public right of way (on the sidewalk) at any of the three entrances. We recommend standing near the Vigil Box, and if there, CPLC sidewalk counselors will direct you to where your public witness at the Southwestern late-term abortion center will be most effective. **Please do not enter the Royal Creek Professional Park or block the driveway or sidewalk while praying at anytime.**

What if my shift is over, and the next pray-er has not arrived?

- **During the daytime** (7 a.m.-7 p.m.), contact Vigil Coordinator, Susan, 214-392-7545 or rp4smp@aol.com, who will find a replacement.
- **During the nighttime** (7 p.m.-7 a.m.), please take all completed sign-in sheets and Statements of Peace with you when you leave and mail them to the CPLC, PO Box 59852, Dallas 75229. (Vigil Box should contain self-addressed envelopes for your use).
- **Please Note:** *If you are part of a church or group covering the day in prayer* and have the number of the next volunteer(s), please call them. If their anticipated arrival is past your departure time, call the numbers above.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: There should always be a minimum of **two people** praying at the vigil site, one of whom should be a **male during nighttime hours** (7 p.m. – 7 a.m.). If you arrive to pray at the site, and are the only person there, please sign in – but please feel free to sit in your car and pray from your car. We appreciate your prayerful presence!!
