- ✦ Youth fees must be paid at time of registration to reserve your space.
- ✦ You may pay online or checks should be made payable to the Catholic Pro-Life Committee or CPLC.
- ✦ Full refunds until June 11th. No refunds one week prior to camp.
- ✦ Registration packets will be mailed 2-3 weeks prior to camp and all information will be available online at that time.

- ✦ Jr. Staff and Chaperone applications must include proof of Safe Environment clearance from your diocese. Applications for Jr. Staff are due June 4th. Applications for Chaperones are due June 11th.




