Project Gabriel provides practical help to a woman who otherwise might not choose life for her unborn baby. Help comes in the form of a Gabriel Angel who supports the mother's choice for life through prayer, ongoing friendship and encouragement, and referrals to parish/community resources. Mothers who request a Gabriel Angel are referred from the White Rose Women's Center, Birth Choice, Angels Clinic, local Christian crisis pregnancy centers and maternity homes, parishes, and Project Gabriel's 972-BABY-DUE hotline.

As a Gabriel Angel you will bring hope, comfort, and friendship to a woman in your community during her pregnancy. Your support witnesses to the value of both the unborn child and the mother who chooses life for her child.
