THE RULES

This year's theme is: "What would our Founding Fathers have to say about *Roe v. Wade*?"

- ♥ Write a 400-word essay reflecting on the theme.
- One full scholarship to the 2011 March for Life will be awarded to the best overall essay. Second place is \$100 towards the trip fee and third place is \$50 towards the trip fee.
- The contest is open to students in grades 9 through 12.
- The essay should be typed, double spaced, and in size 12 Times New Roman or similar font.
- \$\frac{1}{4}\$ Short essays under 350 words and long essays over 400 will not be eligible.
- **♥** Essays are due no later than **November 15, 2010** by 8:00 p.m. Entries may be submitted **online only**.
- **The Grammar and spelling are important and may determine the difference between 1st place and runner up.**
- **♦** Submit your essay online at www.prolifedallas.org/dcmarch.
- Do not include your name or anything that might identify you within your essay. (For example, instead of saying, "I'm the president of the pro-life club at John Smith High School," just say that you're the president of your school pro-life club.)
- ❖ Your essay will be judged by a panel of judges that will not know the author of the essay.
- ♣ Contest results will be announced November 22nd.
