## Activity for February 2015

#### Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 24 women turned away from 3 Dallas abortion facilities; 12 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 82 turnaways, 49 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,973; accepted SWC literature: 14.45%; accepted aftercare literature: 29.03%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Gave a sidewalk counseling training to 30+ people at University of Dallas and scheduled sidewalk counseling training in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City in April.

#### Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 8 calls on English helpline, 7 on Spanish helpline, and 8 emails.
- Conducted reunion for Rachel's Vineyard<sup>TM</sup>
  January Retreat #32 and prepared for Rachel's
  Vineyard<sup>TM</sup> Retreat #54 in English (rescheduled
  for May due to inclement weather).
- Met with FOCUS representative from University of Texas at Dallas regarding ministry materials.
- Presented information on Project Joseph at Parish Pro-Life Coordinators Meeting.
- Continued planning for CBS radio spots and banners for spring release.

## Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 89 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center. YTD Total: 164.
- Five moms referred to Project Gabriel and one paired with an Angel. YTD Totals: 8 referrals, 2 pairings.
- Launched the 2015 spring semester of GEMS with a class on "Money Skills for Life" at Catholic Charities.
