# Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 39 women turned away from the three Dallas abortion facilities; 22 hopefuls. YTD totals: 121 turnaways; 71 hopefuls. Abortion clients at all facilities: 2,736; accepted SWC literature: 14.36%; accepted aftercare literature: 13.83%. Total coverage at all facilities: 100%.
- Hosted, trained and counseled with six mission trip students from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- Scheduled 2015 Quarterly Rosary Processions to abortion facilities with Prayer Ministry.

# Spanish Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Attended Catholic Faith in Action Advocacy Day in Austin, Texas on March 24.
- Collaborated with Speakers Bureau for talk at St. Augustine on God's Plan for the Family and Contraception.
- Met with core group to plan Theology of the Body conference in Spanish co-sponsored by the Natural Family Planning Center of Dallas.
- Began planning for Steps for Life event.

## Youth For Life - Jacquelyn Smith

- Continued preparations for the Pure by Choice Chastity Rally on March 21.
- Held Pure by Choice Chastity Rally in conjunction with Fort Worth Youth for Life. Attended by 290 youth and 40 chaperones.

- Presented to 20 White Rose Women's Center counselors on Project Joseph outreach to men.
- Held support group session for 15 Spanishspeaking retreat graduates of Rachel's Vineyard™ and Project Joseph and planned April support group session for English-speaking retreat graduates of Rachel and Joseph.
