Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 43 women turned away from the four Dallas abortion centers; 17 hopeful turnaways.
 YTD Totals: 545 turnaways, 250 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,295; accepted SWC literature: 13.44%; accepted aftercare literature: 10%. Total coverage at all centers: 99%.
- Gave bilingual Sidewalk Counseling Training to 12 people at St. Michael the Archangel in Garland.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 5 calls on English helpline, 4 on Project Joseph line, 15 on Spanish helpline and 1 email.
- Conducted first Project Joseph Retreat in Spanish for 14 men on November 8.
- Offered after care for both Rachel's Vineyard™
 English-speaking retreat graduates and Project
 Joseph Spanish-speaking retreat graduates.
- Presented information on post-abortion symptoms and gave two testimonials to a local parish youth group of 50 people.

Project Gabriel - Patty Sherrod

- 75 calls received on the 972-BABY-DUE helpline answered at the White Rose Women's Center (YTD Totals: 878).
- Four moms referred to Project Gabriel and one paired with an Angel (YTD totals: 44 referrals, 21 pairings).
- Held GEMS Class on "Christian Parenting IV."
- Revised graduation and scholarship requirements for GEMS program.

Spanish Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Gave talk to Mary Immaculate Religious Education parents on "How to Apply the Pro-Life Message to Marriage."
- Shared pro-life message on Guadalupe Radio Network's Radiothon.
- Attended a gala in New York honoring Corazon Puro.
