Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 35 women turned away from the four Dallas abortion facilities; 23 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 502 turnaways, 233 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all facilities: 1,486; accepted SWC literature: 24.83%; accepted aftercare literature: 24.83%. Total coverage at all facilities: 99%.
- Gave sidewalk counseling training to 25 people at the University of Dallas.
- Helped coordinate Quarterly Rosary Procession to Planned Parenthood South abortion facility.

Spanish Ministry - Aurora Tinajero

- Presented to 50 youth at Nuestra Señora del Pilar Parish on Abortion and scheduled presentation on Faithful Citizenship at St. Patrick.
- Hosted Young Adult Conference "Trasciende" on the culture of death, same-sex attraction, chastity and vocations, with 171 in attendance from Dioceses of Dallas and Fort Worth.
