Convert-to-Life - Joanne Underwood

- 56 women turned away from the four Dallas abortion centers; 26 hopeful turnaways. YTD Totals: 466 turnaways, 210 hopefuls.
- Abortion clients at all centers: 1,695; accepted SWC literature: 64.37%; accepted aftercare literature: 20.51%. Total coverage at all centers: 99%.
- Joanne gave the 40 Days for Life Kickoff keynote for the Catholic Diocese of Tulsa, OK, with 250 people in attendance.

Abortion AfterCare-Healing - Eileen Kuhlmann

- Received 10 calls on the English helpline, 4 on the Project Joseph line, 15 on the Spanish helpline and six emails.
- Presented Project Joseph at Cathedral Shrine of the Virgin of Guadalupe Masses, to St. Mark Hispanic Pro-Life Group, and St. Pius X Men's Group.
- Advertised The Rachel Ministries on GRN and English and Spanish billboards.
